**Technical staff member to support the research infrastructure and research projects

The technician is responsible for the support and maintenance of scientific instrumentation at the Jungfrauoch, and will carry out maintenance work in consultation with the project leaders. This requires travel to Jungfrauoch and the Jungfrau East Ridge, sometimes involving stays of several days at short notice. Daily monitoring of data flows is also part of the duties, as well as preparing statistics on laboratory climate, data quality, and other activities. The technician is responsible for providing and updating documentation on the online portal and for preparing reports for the HFSJG.

Furthermore, we welcome applicants who would like to take an active role in scientific communication at the Jungfrauoch, particularly in supporting the ongoing scientific exhibition, and managing and improving other communication channels. We welcome applications from candidates of all backgrounds, identities, and experiences, and are committed to fostering an inclusive environment that values diversity in all its forms.
